All Teams are guaranteed 2 games: round robin where possible. **3 points for a WIN, 1 point for Tie, Loss 0 points**

Regulation games will be composed of two 12 minutes halves, using a stop clock

Teams will have 2 minutes 30 seconds to warm up prior to their game; half time will be 2 minutes long. Each team will have 1 time out of 1 minute in length to use per game.

Mercy Rule- If teams are separated by 5 goals with ten minutes less remaining In the second half of the game, the game will end. The team will have the option to continue playing, however, the score will not be kept past the mercy rule. Referees and tournament directors reserve the right to cut extra time short to meet any potential rink time restriction.

Any player who is ejected from any game will be barred from the rest of the tournament

If a pool play game is tied after regulation time is completed, the game will end in a tie

In the event of a tie between teams, the following tie breaking order shall be used

Most Win

Fewest Goals allowed

Most Goals scored

Fewest Penalty Minutes

Coin Toss

NO OVERTIMES WILL BE PLAYED UNTIL GOLD MEDAL MATCHES

U9- Overtime for gold medal match- 4 on 4 no goalie for 4.5 minutes, sudden death if goal scored game is complete, if no goal is scored, sudden death shoot out until goal is scored.

U12- Overtime for gold medal match- 4 on 4 no goalie for 4.5 minutes, sudden death if goal scored game is complete, if no goal scored, sudden death shoot out until a goal is scored

U14,U16,U20-In the event of a gold medal match, ending In a tie the winner shall be determined by the best of three shoot out. 3 different players from each team. If still tied after three players shoots from each team, it goes to sudden death until a goal is scored.

Sudden Death Shootout- Must be through the line up- no doubles until every player plays once.
